








EMV Fleet Migration Stakeholder Update Q1 2024

Dear EMV Fleet Migration Stakeholders

The first quarter of 2024 has seen heightened activity on the EMV Fleet Migration project as interoperability testing and scheme certification efforts intensified. While good progress has been made, unfortunately, some technical challenges have resulted in delays to interoperability testing and SAMOS testing. Therefore, the go-live date for stakeholders participating in the project had to be moved out from 18 March to 22 April 2024. The go-live date is being monitored daily and any delays or shift in timelines will be recorded.





Activities for the Quarter

- On a positive note, much progress was subsequently made as one of the issuing banks achieved scheme testing certification with Mastercard and another issuing bank with Visa.
- One acquiring bank has achieved scheme certification with both Visa and Mastercard.
- Continuing support, engagement and industry collaboration increased as participants seek to overcome the challenges they experience.

On the radar

- Ongoing interoperability testing and SAMOS error-free testing will be the main areas of focus for April.
- Preparation for implementation is scheduled for mid-April to be followed by go-live after 22 April.



- POS device preparation and acquirer POS software rollout is planned to commence after April to end May.
- Ongoing change management and communication by issuing and acquiring banks. The project is an industry-wide collaboration and participating banks are ultimately responsible for its practical implementation. They will communicate progress and required actions with their fleet stakeholders, and queries should be directed to them.
